Leading with events, we had a very successful BPNG Advanced Study Day this May in Birmingham. The theme was to support the advanced practitioner, with an interactive afternoon session to revise clinical assessment skills and parenteral nutrition (PN) stability matrices. We were very fortunate to have an excellent line up of speakers looking at fluid assessment, vascular considerations and challenges faced when patients are transitioned from the paediatric to adult home PN service. The day was enjoyed by all. A big thank you to all our presenters, sponsors and delegates.

Our next event will be Fundamentals in Parenteral Nutrition on 15 October 2025 in Birmingham.

This single-day event is aimed at the whole multidisciplinary team, for those new to PN, covering key aspects, such as nutritional assessment, monitoring and formulation stability, for adult and paediatric patient groups. There will also be the opportunity to form networks with healthcare professionals in the same field and gain access to our website resources.
